### Getting to Port Stanley, Ontario.....

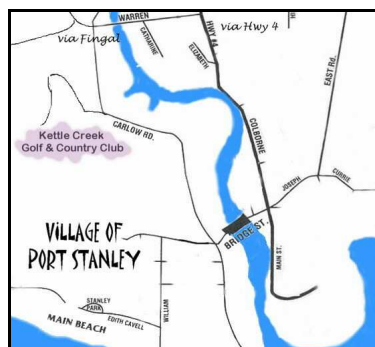


Travelling East on 401: Exit #164 via Union Road South. Follow through Shedden and Fingal to Port Stanley
