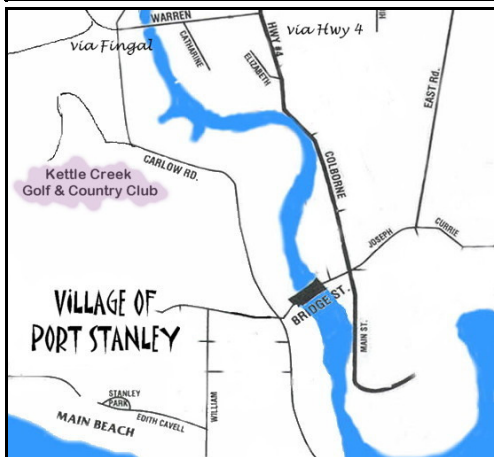

In February 2002, Emily underwent a life-saving double-lung transplant, necessitated after years of lung damage from Cystic Fibrosis. The transplant team at the Toronto Sick Kids Hospital was phenomenal, and with the new lease on life given her, Emily captured the imagination of a community.

Aptly described as "spunky" and "tenacious" by the media, Emily was an absolute pleasure and joy as a daughter, and a loyal protector and best pal as a sister. Her very presence is missed terribly each and every day by her family and friends.
